Blue-Green Algae

- Public Health Notice was posted on August 16, 2018
- Obvious concerns potential health issues, property value concerns, communications
- Is this the new normal?
- Lots of unknowns, but two fairly clear indicators high temperatures and nutrient loads
 - We can't control temperatures
 - We have more control over nutrient loads... "buffers" at lakefront,
 maintaining natural landscape, controlling run-off, eliminating fertilizers
- "Closing of loop" in communications is a problem
 - Signs get posted if test results indicate that a blue-green algae bloom <u>may</u> occur
 - Re-testing is not done...no update provided if bloom does actually not occur



Updates from Armour Township

Clarifications on Planning By-laws...

- Clarification to specify that only one septic system per lot is allowed (requires changes to both the By-Law and the Official Plan).
 Wording was not previously clear and it potentially left the door open for old septic systems to be left on a property after a new structure / septic are completed.
- Specification that a "sleeping cabin / Bunkie" must be a separate structure
 in the Official Plan. Current definition is not fully clear on the fact that
 sleeping cabins have a limited size and they cannot be part of another existing
 structure (whereby the remainder of the structure is considered 'storage').
- Amendment to the Site Plan By-Law to specify that guest sleeping cabins and rural waterfront guest sleeping cabins are not included in the accessory uses, buildings and structures exemption in Section 1-e of the By-Law.


Today's Fire Rating...

Low	Daytime open air burning allowed Nov 1 to March 31. Camp Fires allowed.
Moderate	Daytime open air burning allowed Nov 1 to March 31. Camp Fires allowed.
High	NO OPEN BURNING. Camp Fires for cooking and warmth only.
Extreme	No OPEN BURNING. Camp Fires NOT allowed. Fireworks NOT allowed.

Note that Daytime Burning is NOT Allowed Between April 1 and October 31, No Matter What The Rating...
